

Wally Lennox (St. Peters & BHRDCA) – 1940 to 1978

Wally Lennox was the BHRDCA Treasurer from 1971-72 to 1975-76, which was followed by a stint as BHRDCA President from 1976-77 to 1977-78

Wally first played a season for Box Hill South Progress in 1940-41 before joining St. Peters after WWII. A consistent opening bat, Wally has been found with 3094 runs and 56 wickets up to the completion of the 1964-65 season.

Wally's one century found was 112 not out against Doncaster in 1949-50, while in the 1956-57 'B Grade' Semi Final against East Doncaster, he made 48 and 53 not out. His only Premiership for St. Peters was in 'B Grade' in 1959-60.

Wally's older brother, Jack played with St. Peter's until 1960-61 and is recorded with 273 wickets. Jack served as BHRDCA Secretary in his final season, when Ray McIntosh took a one-year break.
